CHARITABLE TRUST SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

PURPOSE OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

To provide financial assistance to deserving members of Key Club to help them pay for college expenses at a non-profit community college, college, university, technical or vocational school. The financial assistance is to be used for tuition, books or fees.

QUALIFICATIONS

1. The applicant must have been an active member for at least two years of a Key Club in good standing.
2. The applicant must be a graduating senior from one of the following high schools:
 - Boise High School
 - Capital High School
 - Centennial High School
 - Emmett High School
 - Meridian Medical Arts Charter School
 - Rocky Mountain High School
 - Timberline High School

*These clubs are listed by Key Club International as having paid their International and District dues as of April 1, 2019.

3. The applicant must attend a community college, 2-year college, or 4-year university located in Idaho. Applications to for-profit institutions will not be considered.

Submission Requirements

1. Complete the attached application, **in full**.
2. On separate pages,
 - a. Write a one-page (typed, single spaced) essay in which you include the following:
 - A brief introduction of yourself and a description of your college plans
 - An explanation of a unique or special financial need.
 - b. List **School Organizations and Activities** to which you have contributed significantly, stating any office held during your high school career.
 - c. A specific description of your involvement and contribution to **Key Club**. Include service projects, fundraising projects, your length of membership and attendance record.

- d. List any **Church, Community or other Civic Activities** to which you have contributed significantly during your high school career.
 - e. A statement of verification from your Key Club faculty advisor as to the number of service hours you have contributed.
3. A transcript from the high school you are currently attending.

Scholarship Amounts

Each winner will be granted a scholarship in the amount of a minimum of \$1,000.

Selection of Recipients

Selection of the recipients will be made by a committee of Kiwanians from the Division 6 Kiwanis Clubs.
